




- Expectations & Application

2024 - "How do I become a better rider?"



 This is a question coaches across the Team have reported being asked. We LOVE this question. Proof that the Stoke is high and we achieved those goals outlined for the year.

Answer: Details depend a LOT on the specific athlete. However, several basic truths to keep rolling in the right direction.



- Determine your Goals.
- Be on your bike having fun in the <u>Springtime</u>.
- Riding and racing opportunities OUTSIDE OF the MCA & Mtb Team:
 - MN Series, WOW, Buck Hill, WORS, Borah, Lutsen......
 - Local Clubs.
 - Create your own rides and training sessions.
- Age appropriate strength over the winter/spring.
- Sage words of Ted Lasso "BE CURIOUS":
- Research Bike Maintenance & mtb technique videos.
- Practice those skills. Track-stand, Wheel lift, wheelie, manual.
- Coach Mike's secret weapon...
- Ask Captains, fast teammates, coaches.
